Headshot Photography - Frequently Asked Questions

What is the value of a professional portrait?

- Human beings remember what we see as much as ten times longer than what we hear.
- Faces are memorable and make a strong first impression.
- Professional portraits can show -
 - What is different about you and what sets you apart and
 - How serious you are about what you do and the profession you represent.

What should I wear?

It is best to wear clothing that you love and gives you the look you want to accomplish (e.g., friendly, professional, formal, etc.). It is best to avoid large prints.

What happens during the photo session?

We meet at an outdoors location, move from place to place taking photographs, all the while having a good time!

How long is the photo session?

If you're comfortable having your photograph taken, it could be a half hour. Otherwise, expect up to one hour to loosen up and have fun with the camera.

What is the best time of day for an outdoor session?

The lighting is more flattering before 10AM and after 4PM. Overcast skies are fine.

What does the standard pricing include?

The pricing includes a photo session and a review/edit session. Depending on usage, there can be additional levels of pricing. Please feel free to ask about pricing.

Will I get all of the photographs?

You will get many photographs. Some of the photographs will not be included after a quality review.

What will I receive?

You will be given a CD with photographs formatted for web use unless you specify print use.

Where do I take the CD for prints?

There are several recommended places; just ask!

Why do I sign a Model Release?

This is standard protocol when photographing people.

Do I have full rights to the photographs?

The photographer has full rights unless you make arrangements for licensing. In this case, the pricing would differ and a licensing agreement would be prepared and signed.

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
